Certificate in Ayres Sensory Integration (CASI)**

**Step 1: Register for the desired CLASI module.**

- Completion of all 6 modules including assignments is required for the CLASI CASI – Certificate in ASI

- Modules 1, 2, 4, and 5 are offered through online training.
- Modules 3 and 6 are offered onsite.

**Step 2: Familiarize yourself with the CLASI program**

CLASI CASI was designed by experts in occupational therapy and sensory integration who trained and worked directly with Dr. Ayres.

Through this program we hope to establish a cost-effective, accessible educational program through which therapists gain a solid, practical, evidence-based, and effective foundation for using sensory integration theory and practice within their profession toward best practice.

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**Step 3: Get started through onsite and online learning**

**Module 1: Ayres Sensory Integration® (ASI) Theory (online)**

Module 1 is a research-based series of lessons that provide a foundation in ASI theory.

**Module 2: Comprehensive Assessment of ASI (online)**

Module 2 introduces the learner to information on direct and indirect assessments including the Sensory Integration and Praxis Tests (SIPT) through [www.wpspublish.org](http://www.wpspublish.org) and the Evaluation in Ayres Sensory Integration (EASI) (Mailloux, Parham & Smith Roley, 2016).

\*Module 2 is a prerequisite to module 3.

**Step 4: Start testing!**

**Module 3: Comprehensive Assessment in ASI: (onsite)**

This module provides practical hands on practice and review of all aspects of sensory integration and praxis with a variety of assessments that were introduced in module 2.

**Step 5: Hone your skills during learning activities**

**Module 4: Clinical Reasoning using ASI (onsite)**

Module 4 provides information on using research to guide the interpretation of assessment data, linking findings to participation strengths and challenges and guiding intervention planning. Participants prepare a case study for analysis.

\*Module 4 is a prerequisite to modules 5 & 6.

**Module 5: Evidence-Based ASI Intervention including Fidelity to Intervention (onsite)**

Module 5 introduces the research and manualized methods of ASI intervention including the Fidelity to ASI Intervention measure that assists researchers and clinicians to distinguish between interventions that are faithful to the principles of ASI and those that do not meet the criteria.

**Step 6: Refine your intervention skills and document the results**

**Module 6: Evidence-Based ASI Intervention Hands-On Practice and Review (onsite)**

Module 6 provides the opportunity for therapists to observe experts in ASI intervention strategies to work with children in a clinic equipped meeting the criteria outlined in the Fidelity measure.
